Change of Exercise Date


Gentlemen:

Our letter dated November 14, 1990, submitted the emergency exercise objectives for the 1991 Annual Emergency Exercise. The 1991 emergency exercise is the required biennial full participation exercise involving onsite and offsite emergency organizations, and our November 14, 1990 letter stated that this emergency exercise is scheduled for February 12, 1991.

This letter is to notify you that based on discussions and agreements among the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Agency (PEMA), and the NRC, Region I, the 1991 Annual Emergency Exercise for Limerick Generating Station (LGS) is being re-scheduled to be conducted in March 1991, on a date to be determined. This exercise date change will be formalized in communication between PEMA and FEMA. Accordingly, we will submit the 1991 emergency exercise scenario 60 days prior to the 1991 exercise date. We also note that conducting the 1991 full participation emergency exercise in March 1991 is within the time allowed by the NRC in its letter dated August 27, 1990 granting our request for an exemption to conduct the biennial full participation emergency exercise in 1991 rather than 1990.
