The Quad Cities Nuclear Generating Station will be offering a training class for offsite support agencies which may be requested to respond during an emergency. This course is developed for agencies who will require access onsite to perform emergency support functions. Other agencies are welcome to attend this training. Topics specifically related to the Quad Cities Nuclear Generating Station will be covered, and will include notification, site access, site dosimetry issuance, onsite radiological/contamination controls, emergency exposure limits, and special problems which could be encountered on-site during a nuclear emergency.

This class assumes previous participation in the basic radiation course taught by the states of Illinois or Iowa. For individuals who have not completed the State course or for individuals seeking additional radiological training, arrangements can be made to attend the Nuclear General Employee Training (NGET) course taught at the Quad Cities Nuclear Generating Station. In addition, site familiarization tours can be arranged to provide a better understanding of the site facilities and entry/exit locations for emergency vehicles.
