SUBJECT: NRC INSPECTION REPORT NOS. 50-338/90-27 AND 50-339/90-27

This refers to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission's (NRC) inspection of your Fitness For Duty Program, required by 10 CFR Part 26, conducted by William Tobin, Region II, on October 23-25, 1990. At the conclusion of the inspection, the results were discussed at an exit meeting with those members of your staff identified in the enclosed inspection report.

The inspection consisted of selective examinations of your Drug and Alcohol Abuse Policy, corporate and site implementation procedures, chemical testing program, interviews with employees and contractors, observation of your Collection and Medical Facilities and review of pertinent records and reports.

As described in the enclosed report, we are pleased to note several strengths in your program; testing for a broader panel of drugs than NRC requires, the management of your Fitness For Duty staff, and the thoroughness of your Quality Assurance audits.

The NRC has identified an Unresolved Item relative to providing access to any tests records for individuals subject to Part 26 as required by Appendix A, Subpart C, Section 3.2. Your attention is directed to NUREG-1354, "Fitness For Duty in the Nuclear Power Industry: Responses to Public Comments", question #14.3.1, wherein the NRC states that it expects, "... licensee management to provide the worker with all records, documents, and chain-of-custody forms relating to the finding of initial and positive test results..." We are requesting that NRC's Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation review your position relative to this issue and will advise you of the results of that review.


