

SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE

Since SECY 82-111 and SECY 82-111B address among other matters, the issue of minimum staffing for emergency situations at nuclear power plants and represents recent Commission policy on this subject, we request that you review, in light of these documents, the Wisconsin Electric Power Company submittals (Attachment 1) related to staffing at their Point Beach Unit 1 and 2 facilities. In your review, please consider the information provided in the attached letter from Region III (Keppler to Denton, June 1, 1982, Attachment 2). Your safety evaluation of this information is requested by October 22, 1982. Based on your safety evaluation we will seek, in conjunction with Region III, to resolve this issue with the licensee. In the event you disagree with any or all of the licensee's deviations from the SECY 82-111 goals, please provide the technical basis for your conclusion. Given the Commission's guidance on SECY 82-111 that the staffing levels in Table B-2 should be treated as goals, a simple assertion that the licensee's position does not meet the staffing levels in Table B-2 would not be a sufficient technical basis.
