APPENDIX A

NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Baltimore Gas and Electric Company Calvert Cliffs Nuclear Power Plant Docket/License Nos. 50-317; DPR-53 50-318; DPR-69

As a result of the inspection conducted October 21, 1990, through November 24, 1990, and in accordance with the "General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions," 10 CFR Part 2, Appendix C (Enforcement Policy) (1990), the following violation was identified:

The NRC-Approved Calvert Cliffs Physical Security Plan, Revision 22, dated September 1988, Section 5.2, Picture Badge System, states, in part, that . . . After proper identification is presented in the security processing building, the individual will receive his/her badge, which will permit access to those portions of the plant required by his/her duties. Section 5.4 of the plan, access/entry, states, in part, that . . . Personnel are required to enter the protected area through the security processing building, via a locked entry portal which is controlled by card access or manually by a nuclear security force member.

Contrary to the above, on October 22, 1990, at 1610 hours, an individual was permitted access to the plant protected area (PA) by a nuclear security force member, through the security processing building without being issued a PA access badge.

This is a Severity Level IV Violation (Supplement III).

Pursuant to the provisions of 10 CFR 2.201, Baltimore Gas and Electric Company is required to submit to this office within thirty days of the date of the letter which transmitted this Notice, a written statement or explanation in reply, including: (1) the corrective steps which have been taken and the results achieved; (2) corrective steps which will be taken to avoid further violations; and, (3) the date when full compliance will be achieved. Where good cause is shown, consideration will be given to extending this response time.

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
