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STANDARD FORM 30 (REV. 10-83) Prescribed by GSA FAR (48 CFR) 53.243 The purpose of this modification is to: 1) increase the contract ceiling and obligated amounts by \$37,597.98 from \$149,199.51 to \$186,797.49 to reflect costs associated with additional reporting requirements, 2) revise the delivery schedule, 3) extend the period of performance, and 4) modify Section I.2. Option to Extend the Term of Contract, to reflect the two month extension in the basic period of performance. Therefore the contract is modified as follows:

- Under Section B.2 CONSIDERATION AND OBLIGATION--COST PLUS FIXED FEE (JUNE 1988) ALTERNATE I (JUNE 1988), paragraphs a and d are deleted in their entirety and the following paragraphs are substituted in lieu thereof:
 - "a. The total estimated cost to the Government for full performance of this contract is \$186,797.49, of which the sum of \$175,109.05 represents the estimated reimbursable costs, and of which \$11,688.44 represents the fixed fee."
 - "d. The amount presently obligated by the Government with respect to this contract is \$186,797.49."
- Under Section C, DESCRIPTION/SPECIFICATION/WORK STATEMENT, subsection C.1.4. is revised to read as follows:

C.1.4. DELIVERY SCHEDULE

Task 1 letter report due on or before June 25, 1990

Task 2:

Draft NUREG/CR and Training materials due on or before December 14, 1990

NRC's Review of draft NUREG/CR and Training materials due on or before January 11, 1991

Final NUREG/CR and Training materials due on or before February 8, 1991.

Task 3 report due on or before September 24, 1991, pending exercise of option.

Task 4 report due on or before November 24, 1991, pending exercise of option.

3. Under Section F.6, DURATION OF CONTRACT PERIOD, the first sentence is deleted in its entirety and the following is substituted in lieu thereof:

"This contract shall commence on the February 26, 1990 and shall expire on February 8, 1991."

4. Section 1.2, OPTION TO EXTEND THE TERM OF THE CONTRACT--SERVICES, is revised to reflect the addition two months extension as follows:

"The Government may extend the term of this contract by written notice to the contractor within three weeks after receipt of draft reports required by Task 2 herein. If the Government exercises this option, the extended contract shall be considered to include this option provision. The total duration of this contract including the exercise of any options, shall not exceed 20 months.

All others terms and conditions remain unchanged.
