REQUEST (TAC NO. 77146)

By letter dated May 7, 1990, you applied for an amendment to the Grand Gulf Nuclear Station, Unit 1, Operating License No. NPF-29. The proposed amendment would change the Technical Specifications (TS) Section 3/4.7.2, "Control Room Emergency Filtration System," by identifying six air-operated isolation valves in the system as those required by TS 4.7.2.d.2 to close within 4 seconds. The present TS implies that all valves in the system must be verified to close within 4 seconds, including two fresh air inlet valves which are motor-operated and designed to close in about 75 seconds. The basis for this implication was Updated Final Safety Analysis Report (UFSAR), Table 18.1-2, "Control Room Isolation Damper Characteristics," which erroneously listed all eight valves as having a maximum closing time of 4 seconds.

Your letter dated December 7, 1990, withdrew the amendment request because UFSAR Table 18.1-2 was corrected by deleting the two motor-operated valves from the table and adequate clarification regarding the safety function and surveillance testing of these two valves had been provided in meetings with the NRC staff on October 23 and November 6, 1990. Staff summaries of the meetings were issued on November 28 and November 30, 1990, respectively. The UFSAR change was submitted by licensee's letter dated December 1, 1990.

Your proposed amendment is considered withdrawn.
