

Sequoyah Fuels Corporation (SFC) has completed actions required by the NRC's September 19, 1990 Order Modifying License. I have enclosed a copy of a final report, "Main Process Bui' ing Investigation Final Findings Report," which addresses a lirements 1 through 5 in the Order. I have previously sent you a copy of SFC's "Facility Environmental Investigation Plan," which responds to requirement number 6 in the Order.

In my letter to you of October 30, 1990, I committed to a prioritized water level monitoring frequency in certain wells that had not then attained static conditions, resulting in delaying our final report. Since the report is now finalized, SFC is discontinuing this special monitoring commitment.
