

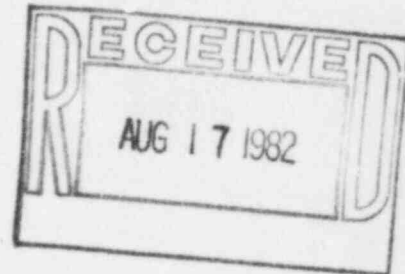

Incorporation of Oak Ridge Agreement
into AP&L Emergency Response Plans

Gentlemen:

In our letter to you dated April 8, 1982, (ØCANØ482Ø5) in response to Appendix A item 2, we stated that AP&L's contract with Oak Ridge National Laboratory for post accident sampling would be incorporated into the next revision of the AP&L Nuclear Contingency Plan which was then scheduled for completion in July 1982. This contract was to be included in revision 1 to Contingency Plan Procedure 9. This revision to Procedure 9 has not yet been made.

In conversations with NRC's Mr. Charles Hackney during the week of July 19, 1982, Mr. Hackney recommended that AP&L include in its emergency response plans, agreements with additional offsite support agencies. Based on Mr. Hackney's recommendations, additional evaluation of Contingency Plan Procedure 9 is now being conducted. Due to this additional effort, revision 1 to Contingency Plan Procedure 9 is now scheduled for completion on September 17, 1982. Unless you recommend differently, we will incorporate the Oak Ridge agreement in our September 17, 1982 revision.
