SUBJECT: GRAND GULF NUCLEAR STATION, UNIT 1 - RESPONSE TO GENERIC LETTER 89-13, "SERVICE WATER SYSTEM PROBLEMS AFFECTING SAFETY-RELATED EQUIPMENT" (TAC NO. 74008)

By letter dated January 29, 1990, the licensee (System Energy Resources, Inc. before June 6, 1990, and Entergy Operations, Inc. on or after that date) submitted the first of two required responses to Generic Letter (GL) 89-13. This submittal describes programs to implement the five recommended actions in GL 89-13. The staff accepts your response as a commitment to each of the five recommended actions, or to an equally effective alternative course of action for one or more of them. Accordingly, we accept your response as fulfilling this requirement of GL 89-13.

As indicated in GL 89-13, if a licensee chooses a course of action different from the recommended actions, the licensee should document and retain in appropriate plant records a justification that the heat removal requirements of the service water systems are satisfied by use of the alternative program.

The second of the two responses to GL 89-13 is required to be submitted within 30 days of the completion of all initial tests or activities in the program and establishment of continuing programs as required by the generic letter.
