Thank you for informing us of the corrective and preventive actions documented in your letters. These actions will be examined during a future inspection of your licensed program.

Based on a telephone conversation between Mr. R. Gallo of this office and Mr. C. Frizzle of your staff on October 19, 1982, regarding Item D of Appendix A to our letter, we understand that plant positions in response to 1981 audits have been developed and that plant positions in response to outstanding 1982 audits will be developed by October 31, 1982. In addition, plant procedure, 0-00-3, will be revised to require a management conference within 30 working days to facilitate prompt audit finding responses.
