Gentlemen:

This refers to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission's (NRC) inspection of your Fitness for Duty Program, implemented in accordance with 10 CFR Part 26, conducted by D. Schuster and D. Schaefer, Region V, on November 13-16, 1990. At the conclusion of the inspection, the results were discussed at an exit meeting with you and members of your staff identified in the enclosed inspection report. Further, this letter refers to a telephone discussion between M. Shaw, PGE, and D. Schaefer of this office on November 26, 1990.

The inspection consisted of selective examinations of your Drug and Alcohol Abuse Policies, corporate and site implementation procedures, chemical testing program, interviews with employees and contractors, observations of your site collection facility, and review of pertinent records and reports.

Within the scope of this inspection, no violations were identified.

As described in the enclosed report, we are pleased to note numerous strengths in your program: Management's strong support of the program; the use of a lower cutoff level for marijuana and testing for larger number of drugs than NRC requires; cross training of courier and laboratory technicians; incorporation and use of peer support groups; a strong self assessment program which includes Quality Assurance audits and internal reviews; and the professionalism and expertise of the Medical Review Officer, Fitness for Duty Coordinator, Employee Assistant Program Specialist, and Supervising Medical Technologist. Also there were some weaknesses identified. While we encourage their correction, none of these weaknesses were considered significant.

In accordance with Section 2.790 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice" Part 2. Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, a copy of this letter and its enclosure will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room.
