As you indicate in your report, certain activities appeared to be in noncompliance with NRC requirements. Items 1, 2, 3, and 5a were corrected prior to the completion of the inspection and no reply to these items is required.

Regarding Items 4 and 5b, a written response is addressed in the enclosure to this letter, including the corrective action taken, corrective steps to be taken to avoid further items of noncompliance, and dates when full compliance will be achieved.

Your report also identified two concerns relating to personnel access controls to the protected area and maintenance of security-related equipment. During the exit interview, the licensee satisfactorily identified corrective actions regarding your concerns. The actions will be available for your review on future inspections.
