Gentlemen:

Reference (a) was our response to NRC Bulletin 90-01. In Reference (b), NUMARC identified additional "suspect lot" transmitters. We have reviewed our records and determined that two of these transmitters are installed in engineered safety features actuation systems. No other suspect lot transmitters are in use or in stock at Calvert Cliffs Nuclear Power Plant.

In Bulletin 90-01, you requested that we identify where suspect lot transmitters are installed and a schedule for replacing them (Reporting Requirement 1.c). Accordingly, this information is provided below:


