Pursuant to delegation by the Commission dated December 29, 1972, published in the Federal Register, 37 F.R. 28710 (1972), and Sections 2.105, 2.700, 2.702, 2.714, 2.714a, 2.717 and 2.721 of the Commission's Regulations, all as amended, an Atomic Safety and Licensing Board is being established in the following proceeding to rule on petitions for leave to intervene and/or requests for hearing and to preside over the proceeding in the event that a hearing is ordered.

This Board is being established pursuant to a notice published by the Commission on October 19, 1990, in the Federal Register (55 F.R. 42527) entitled, "Notice of Consideration of Issuance of a Materials License for the Storage of Spent Fuel and Notice of Opportunity for a Hearing". The proposed license would authorize the

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Nuclear Generating Plant, Units 1 and 2, in dry storage cask at an ISFSI to be constructed at the applicant's Prairie Island Nuclear Generating Plant site. (Operating Licenses DPR-2013 and 2014.) Pursuant to the provisions of 10 C.F.R. Part 72, the term of the license for the ISFSI would be twenty (20) years.


