The Nuclear Regulatory Commission recently received an allegation (AMS No. RIII-90-A-0125) concerning alleged drug sales by a Zion Station employee. After a review of your investigation we concluded that there are no safety concerns stated and there is no regulatory basis for further action on our part.

Your investigation indicated that the named individual did not work at the Zion Station and in fact has never been badged at Zion.

We found your investigation to be sufficient to support your conclusions and have no additional questions regarding this matter. We request that you retain the supporting documentation for your investigation of this allegation for a minimum of one year from the date of this letter.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790 of the Commission's regulations, a copy of this letter will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room.
