This is in response to your October 3, 1990 letter citing a violation of 10 CFR Part 2, Appendix C at our facility.


The issue was a built-in access ladder on a large blast cleaning facility located adjacent to the radiographic facility. The inspector contended that it was possible for a person to climb the ladder and, were he agile enough, gain access to the roof of the radiograph room, bypassing the interlocks positioned at the proper access points.

Acknowledging that it would be possible, even through highly improbable, Dresser has physically cut the lower six feet of ladder away from the equipment. "Before and after" photographs are enclosed.

We request that this action be accepted as a resolution of the violation.

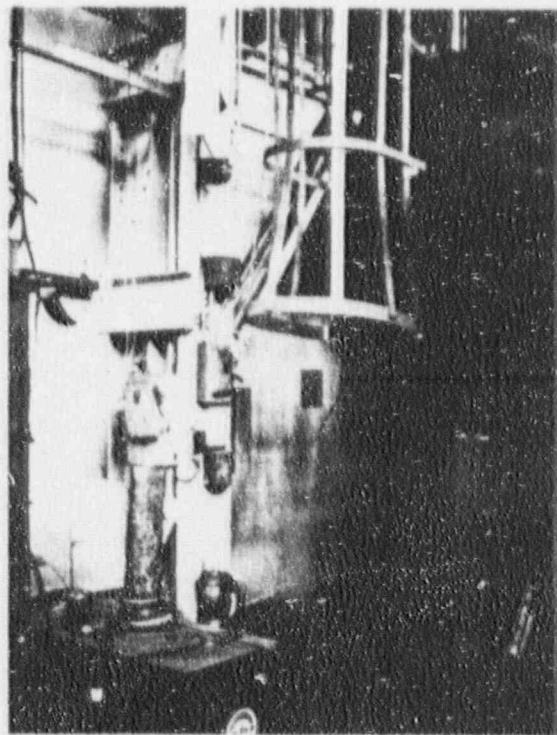
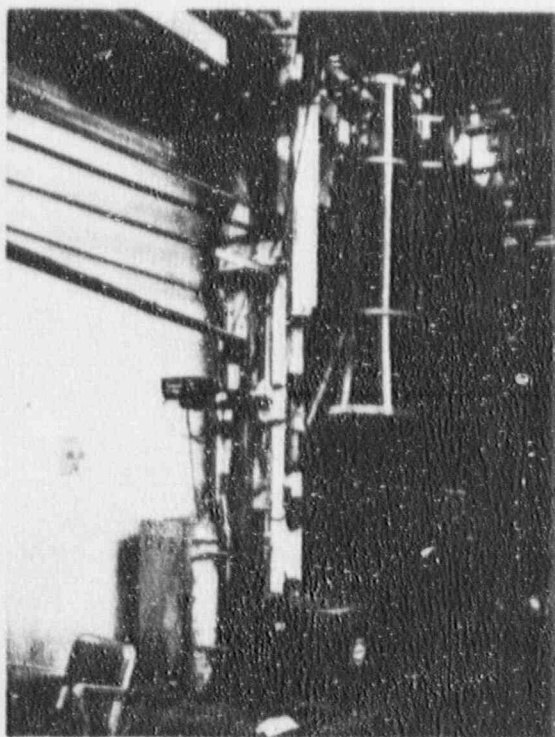
