12. DESCRIPTION OF AMENDMENT/MODIFICATION

This Modification No. 3 is issued to provide for the continuance of the efforts which were required in the original contract; to expand the scope of work; to extend the period of performance; to revise the reporting requirements; to provide for travel and miscellaneous expenses; and to increase the monetary value of the contract.

The contract is hereby modified as follows:

Under ARTICLE II - SCOPE OF WORK, add:

"f. The contractor shall continue data collection efforts in order to analyze geologic and water quantity data as they become available.

g. The contractor shall carry out computer modeling of the transport of contaminants in the aquifer at the UNC plant site. The final result of this analysis shall consist of illustrations, tables, and recommendations for inclusion in the NRC's Safety Evaluation Report.

h. The contractor may be requested to serve as an expert witness at public meetings with Rhode Island concerned citizens and public officials."

Except as provided herein, all terms and conditions of the document referenced in block 8, as heretofore changed, remain unchanged and in full force and effect.

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2. Delete ARTICLE III - PERIOD OF PERFORMANCE in its entirety and substitute the following in lieu thereof:

"The period of performance for this contract shall be from September 17, 1980 through September 30, 1983."

3. ARTICLE IV - CONSIDERATION, is revised as follows:

The previous estimation of approximately nineteen mandays is increased by approximately 16 mandays, to a new total of approximately 35 mandays.

Subparagraph e. is revised to read: "Per diem shall be reimbursed at a daily rate not to exceed \$50.00 per day."

In addition to the direct and indirect allowable charges under this contract, Dr. Warner is authorized to receive payment in an amount not to exceed \$2,000.00 for the following items :

- a. travel expenses, as outlined above, with prior written permission from the NRC Project Officer;
- b. reasonable telephone charges;
- c. computer time;
- d. student aid expenses;
- e. USGS computer printouts; and
- f. minor material purchases required for performance of the work herein.

4. ARTICLE V - OBLIGATIONS, is revised to read:

"The amount presently obligated by the NRC with respect to this contract is \$20,000.00."

5. ARTICLE VII - REPORTING REQUIREMENTS, is deleted in its entirety and the following substituted in lieu thereof:

"At the completion of this effort, Dr. Warner shall document his findings and recommendations in a final assessment report which shall be submitted to the NRC Project Officer.

In addition to the final assessment report, Dr. Warner shall provide special interest reports to the NRC Project Officer not less than one each quarter. These reports should include items of interest, significant travel, and a summary of information from public meetings. Should items of particular interest occur, a special interest report shall be prepared and submitted to the NRC Project Officer."

6. The results of these changes will increase the total monetary value of the contract by \$10,000.00, from \$10,000.00 to a new total amount of \$20,000.00.

All other terms and conditions remain the same.
