The inspection consisted of a selective examination of procedures and representative records, observations, independent measurements, and interviews with personnel. In addition to the above areas, the inspectors examined actions taken to correct violations identified during our September 30, 1985, inspection. We have no further questions regarding your actions pertaining to the inventory and labeling violations, however, the violation pertaining to leak tests is a repeat item. In your response to this letter please describe why your proposed corrective action is expected to be more successful in preventing future violations in this area. During this inspection, certain of your activities appeared to be in violation of NRC requirements, as specified in the enclosed Notice. A written response is required. In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790 of the Commission's regulations, a copy of this letter, the enclosures, and your response to this letter will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room.
