Thank you for your three letters responding to our letter and Notice of Violation dated October 5, 1990. Your two October 29, 1990 letters responded to the identified violations and concerns raised by the NRC and the November 29, 1990 letter detailed your analysis of allegations forwarded by the NRC.

Your responses outlined corrective action with respect to the violations and concerns noted. The allegation analysis indicated that the three allegations were not substantiated. We found your investigation to be sufficient to support your conclusions and have no additional questions regarding these matters. We request that you retain the supporting documentation for your investigation of the allegations for a minimum of one year from the date of this letter.
