By way of this note I'm asking all Asst. Dir. in DL to follow this approach even if in doubt to send EIS's to DWM for review. Your continued cooperation is appreciated. JBM

The purpose of this memorandum is to follow-up on our earlier discussion on how to improve our interface in the preparation of Environmental Impact Statements (EIS's) involving waste management, based on the recent experience in finalizing the EIS for the Dresden 1 decontamination. Specifically, to ensure Division of Waste Management supervisory attention in support of both the technical content and schedules for future EIS's, I suggest the following:

1. Requests for Division of Waste Management (WM) participation in preparation of the waste management portions of both draft and final EIS's should be requested in writing.
2. Requests for WM concurrence to publish the completed draft and final EIS's should also be requested in writing to ensure the portions covering WM's areas of responsibility are reviewed for consistency with the total context of the document.
3. All written requests for WM actions should be addressed to me and identify the date by which actions are required to support NRR schedules. Requests requiring substantial WM effort should be made as early as possible, preferably two weeks in advance of the requested action.

Please let me know if you agree.
