NOTICE OF VIOLATION

As a result of the inspection conducted on November 14 and 15, 1990, and in accordance with the "General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions," 10 CFR Part 2, Appendix C, (1989) (Enforcement Policy) the following violations were identified:

 License Condition No. 11 designates a specific individual as Chairman of the Radionuclide Radiation Safety Committee.

Contrary to the above, the designated individual has not served as Chairman of the Radionuclide Radiation Safety Committee since at least June 1990.

This is a Severity Level IV violation (Supplement VI)..

2. License Condition No. 29 requires that licensed material be possessed and used in accordance with the statements, representations, and procedures contained in certain referenced applications and letters.

The referenced application dated April 9, 1985, states in Item 15 I.A. that all areas where radionuclides are used and stored will be posted in accordance with 10 CFR 19.11. 10 CFR 19.11(a) requires each licensee to post current copies of Parts 19 and 20, the license, and the license documents.

Contrary to the above, the inspector observed that the required documents were not posted in nine laboratories where radionuclides are used and stored.

This is a Severity Level V violation (Supplement VI).

Pursuant to the provisions of 10 CFR 2.201, you are required to submit to this office within thirty days of the date of this Notice a written statement or explanation in reply, including for each violation: (1) the corrective steps that have been taken and the results achieved; (2) the corrective steps that will be taken to avoid further violations; and (3) the date when full compliance will be achieved. Consideration may be given to extending your response time for good cause shown.
