

NOTICE OF VIOLATION

General License (10 CFR 31.5)

As a result of the telephone conversation conducted on December 10, 1990, and in accordance with the "General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions," 10 CFR Part 2, Appendix C, (1990) (Enforcement Policy) the following violation was identified:

10 CFR 31.5(c)(8) requires that any person who acquires, receives, possesses, uses, or transfers byproduct material in a device pursuant to the general license in paragraph (a) of this section, transfer or dispose of the device only by transfer to a person holding a specific license to receive the device.


Contrary to the above, during the period of September 1988 to August 1989, a Nuclecel, Model P2051, static eliminator containing a nominal 10 millicuries of polonium-210 was transferred or disposed of in an unauthorized manner.

This is a Severity Level IV violation (Supplement VI).

No response to this violation is required.
