SUBJECT: ZIMMER MEETING ON SEPTEMBER 27, 1982 AND

CONFERENCE CALL ON SEPTEMBER 30, 1982

Meeting

A meeting was held at 10:00 a.m. on September 27, 1982, at the Region III office at the request of Cincinnati Gas and Electric Company (CG&E) to discuss proposed organization changes and other general items concerning the Zimmer project. The meeting was between E. A. Borgmann and members of his staff and J. G. Keppler and members of his staff. Mr. L. L. Kintner of NRR was also in attendance. The organization changes proposed by CG&E realigned the groups reporting to the Executive Vice President (Mr. Borgmann) and the Vice President - Nuclear (Mr. Sylvia).

The proposed changes included splitting the QCP away from QA creating two groups, making QA a more manageable task, and elevating both QA and the QCP to the level of the Engineering and Construction Departments. The proposal called for all four to report to the Executive Vice President. As proposed, the Vice President - Nuclear would manage Plant Operation, Preoperational and Startup Testing, Licensing, and Nuclear Services.

The NRC was concerned that the proposed organization might be perceived to emphasize completion of construction and startup and operation and not emphasize the importance and independence of QA/QC and the QCP.

The licensee agreed to consider the NRC concerns and to rethink their position on the proposed organizational changes.

The status of the QA Manual for Construction was discussed including the method the licensee would utilize to update the necessary documents. This item was to be reviewed by the NRC to determine the necessary actions required by the licensee.

A conference call was conducted at 9:00 a.m. on September 30, 1982, between NRC staff members and CG&E staff members to discuss the need and method available to update the licensee QA Plan for construction contained in the PSAR (1971), and to provide the QA Plan for construction and operation to the NRC for review as appropriate. Further discussions will be held between the NRC and the licensee to establish a firm schedule for completion of the reviews. The initial discussions are planned during the week of October 4, 1982, with the completion of the CG&E reviews and submitted plan during the next few weeks.

The meeting and conference call will be documented in the Zimmer monthly inspection report.
