Ostr on October 20, 1982, this letter is being submitted to req that the subject license be amended to reflect a recent organizational change at the Callaway Plant. Specifically, the position of Assistant Superintendent, Engineering-Radiation-Chemical as addressed in condition no. 11 of the Materials License and in Section III of your October 4, 1982 Safety Evaluation Report has been changed to the newly created position of Superintendent, Health Physics. The Health Physics program at the Callaway Plant is carried out under the direction of the Superintendent, Health Physics. He reports directly to the Assistant Manager-Technical Services who reports directly to the Manager-Callaway Plant. The minimum technical qualifications for the Superintendent, Health Physics are identical to those for the Assistant Superintendent, Engineering-Radiation-Chemical as currently stated in Section III of the Safety Evaluation Report and in condition no. 11 of the Materials License.


