Pennsylvania Power & Light Company has reviewed the proposed revision to Regulatory Guide 3.15 and has developed some comments for your consideration. We believe these comments will lead to a clearer document.

<u>Section</u>	<u>Comment</u>
1.1.3	The meaning of 'quantities' should be more clearly defined (e.g., Kg).
1.1.3	Does phrase 'normal uranium' mean 'natural uranium'?
1.1.3	This section asks for maximums per assembly. It should be clearly stated as maximum pin average values per assembly or maximum pin values in an assembly.
1.2	This section should address whether the fuel will be stored in a wet pool or a dry area and what the chemical environment is.
2.2	This section should also address wet storage.
