This transmission confirms the telephone report of October 25, 1982 by D.G. Mitchell to E. Greenman of your staff, regarding the failure of both Stand By Gas Treatment Systems to operate during a surveillance test. Both trains had been declared operable, based on previous surveillance tests and the SGTS would not have been retested prior to heatup.
