SUBJECT: NRC INSPECTION REPORT 50-313/90-35; 50-368/90-35

This refers to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) inspection conducted November 26-30, 1990 of activities authorized for Arkansas Nuclear One (ANO). At the conclusion of the inspection, the findings were discussed with you and members of your staff.

The inspection was performed to evaluate your corrective actions to previous inspection findings and violations on Units 1 and 2. Further, the inspection reviewed licensee corrective actions for findings identified in the ANO Unit 2 Emergency Operating Procedure (EOP) inspection conducted from February 27 through April 6, 1990 (NRC Inspection Report 50-368/90-01).

The inspectors determined that the proper corrective actions had been performed to close six followup items from various inspection reports associated with ANO Units 1 and 2. Review of the EOP followup corrective actions revealed that the intended corrective actions had been taken. The inspectors ascertained that the training administered to the operators to familiarize them with the procedure revision was sufficient in scope and depth to assure valid training and subsequent safe operation of the facility.

Within the scope of the inspection, no violations or deviations were identified.

This report includes specific inspection followup for selected Diagnostic Evaluation Team findings (NRC Inspection Report 50-313/88-36; 50-368/88-36 issued December 21, 1989).
