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1. The application should be revised to include the supplement dated August 16, 1966, and page number 18 from the supplement dated November 5, 1968.
2. The application for the Model Nos. MW-3000 and Sentinel 8 should be revised to include specific sections on operating procedures that are complete, current and conforms with 10 CFR Part 71 Subpart G. These sections should provide, as a minimum operating procedures, presented sequentially in the order in which the operations are performed. The procedures should address items such as inspection prior to shipment, cautionary notes on package handling, limits on package contents, installation of security seals and labels, determination that the external radiation is within regulatory limits, and instructions pertinent to receiving and unloading the package.
