Dear Mr. Miller:

Pursuant to the telephone conversation of October 6, 1982, between Mr. J. B. Masaitis, Chairman of United States Steel Corporation Radiation Committee, and Messrs. Lasuk and Weidman of your office, this letter clarifies the additional action we are taking regarding Items 3 and 4 of the Notice of Violation, dated August 27, 1982.

The corrective action that we are taking to avoid future non-compliance with the violations discussed in Items 3 and 4 is as follows:

Item 3:

We will maintain a log-record of survey instrument calibrations which will include:

- 1. Dates when instruments are next due for calibration.
- 2. Dates when instruments were calibrated.

Timely notification to the responsible departments will be made approximately 30 days prior to the next due date for survey instrument calibrations.

Item 4:

We will maintain a log-record of wipe tests for our devices which will include:


1. Dates when devices are next due for wipe test.

2. Dates when wipe tests are completed.

Timely notification to responsible personnel will be made approximately 30 days prior to the due dates for the next wipe tests.
