CLAUSE D. Task 2. December 16-21, 1990: On-site inspection

December 16- As necessary Contractor will travel to the Diablo Canyon site to be available on the morning of December 17 at the NRC Resident's office of the Diablo Canyon Facility at 8.00 a.m to meet with the Technical Monitor to confirm the inspection protocol and commence inspection of the facility.

Independent inspection by the contract will proceed over total period of 5 days at the site. A r.e-exit meeting will be held with Regional representatives on the afternoon of Thursday December 20 for which a draft report will be prepared by the contractor for presentation and discussion. A final draft report will be prepared by the contractor for an Exit meeting with the licensee on the morning of Friday December 21: this meeting is expected to conclude by 10.00 a.m. to enable departure of the contractor for Home Office.

CLAUSE D. Task No 3. December 24-31, 1990: Prepare input to draft Final inspection report.

At Home office, contractor prepares this input over a total period of 40 hrs and to be sent by expedited delivery to reach the Technical Monitor by no later than 10 a.m Wednesday January 02 1991.

In addition to the hard copy of the report, the contractor shall provide an electronic copy of the report to the NRC Technical Monitor as IBM compatible software (Word Perfect or other mutually agreeable IBM PC compatible word processing software)

CLAUSE D. Task 4. JANUARY 02-04 1991

At Home Office, on January 02 1991, the contractor answer's requests for clarification by Technical Monitor in his preparation of h: Final Inspection Report.
