As a result of the NRC's <u>Notice Of Violation</u> the following action is being taken:

Item #1:

License No. 13-07964-05

Our license expiration date is September 30, 1982, we have included a more realistic radiation survey program in our request for renewal.

License No. 37-02375-17

We will request an amendment to our license which will formulate a new radiation safety program which can be more realistically carried out.

The amendment is now being worked on and should be received by the NRC about November 15, 1982.

We are requesting that the radiation surveys may be made by the Division Radiation Officers or designated alternates, NRC approved and licensed contractors and manufacturers of radiation devices. One individual may not always be available because of illness, vacations, et cetera.

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Item #2:

The manufacturers of our radiation devices under our License 37-02375-17 and 13-07964-05 have been contracted to inspect each device and shall replace the labels identifying the radioactive contents and the labels with the radiation symbol and the words, "CAUTION, RADIOACTIVE MATERIALS" or "DANGER RADIOACTIVE MATERIALS" that are not legible. This should be completed on or about October 30, 1982.

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New "Radiation-Caution" signs with the radiation symbol have been ordered to replace those signs that are not legible in the area of the gauges. We expect to complete the replacement of these signs on or about October 30, 1982.

Item #3:

Our "Radiation Pattern Survey Sheet" will be amended by September 30, 1982, so that it will show which survey instrument is used (by serial number) and it's calibration date.

We will amend our License No. 37-02375-17 to coincide with our License No. 13-07964-05. Our amendment should be received by the NRC about November 15, 1982.

Item #4:

An NRC approved vendor has made wipe tests for all our radiation devices under our License No. 37-02375-17.

An NRC approved vendor was contracted to make wipe tests of all our devices under our License No. 13-07964-05. These wipe tests were completed September 23, 1982.

Compliance of testing for leakage and/or contamination was completed as of September 23, 1982, and will continue to be done as required in the future.
