Gentlemen:

In Licensee Event Report (LER) 90-28, Portland General Electric Company committed to train work planners on how to maintain equipment seismic qualification requirements when preparing work instructions. This was to be accomplished by December 31, 1990 by including the necessary information in the training plan being developed for work planners. The analysis of training needs and curriculum model phases of the training plan have been completed and some of the training modules are complete. Other modules are under development. Approximately 20 modules have not started development. Due to resource constraints, the training plan for work planners will not be totally completed until June 15, 1991. Interim training for work planners was completed in August 1990 by reviewing the LER. Emphasis was placed on the need to restore mounting hardware for equipment to the as designed condition to maintain the seismic qualification configuration of the equipment.
