Gentlemen,

We have reviewed your application dated July 16, 1990 requesting amendment to NRC License Number 24-20089-01 and find that we will need additional information as follows:

1. If training other than that given by the device manufacturer will be provided to employees, a description of the alternative training, including the topics covered in training, the time spent on each topic, and the name and qualifications of the instructor must be provided. A qualified instructor should have training in radiation safety equivalent to completion of an 80 hour course in radiation safety principles and practices and should have experience in the use of the device.
2. Confirm that film badges will be changed at one month intervals.

We will continue our review of your application upon receipt of this information. Please reply in duplicate, within 10 days, and refer to Control Number 89888.

Upon failure to file a response within the specified time, we will consider that you have abandoned your request and will void this action. This is without prejudice to resubmission of the application.


Enclosed is our application and fee for amendment to the referenced license.

Only employees who have completed the gauge manufacturer's training program or equivalent, been instructed in the organization's operating and emergency procedures, demonstrated their proficiency in safe use of the gauge, and been provided with personnel monitoring equipment will operate the gauge. Certificates documenting the employees training are maintained on file during the individual's employment.
9. Gauges will be maintained under constant surveillance and immediate control of an authorized user or will be locked in a transport vehicle under our control or in locked storage locations in our laboratories. See Attachment 1.
10. (1) All personnel authorized to operate the gauge will wear a film badge when operating the gauge.
(2) Leak tests will be performed on each gauge at 6-month intervals. The Troxler Model 3880 Leak Test Kit provided by Troxler Electronic Laboratories, Inc., P.O. Box 12057, Research Triangle Park, NC 27709, will be used.
(3) Any maintenance performed by the licensee will be performed with the source in the safe shielded position.
(4) Packaging and transport of gauges will be conducted in accordance with applicable DOT regulations.

- (5) Written operating and emergency procedures are provided to all personnel who use the gauge. The procedures include:
- (a) Use of personnel monitoring dosimeters
 - (b) Operating instructions for the gauge
 - (c) Gauge storage and transportation

11. Any necessary disposal will be by transfer of the radioactive material to a licensee specifically authorized to possess it.

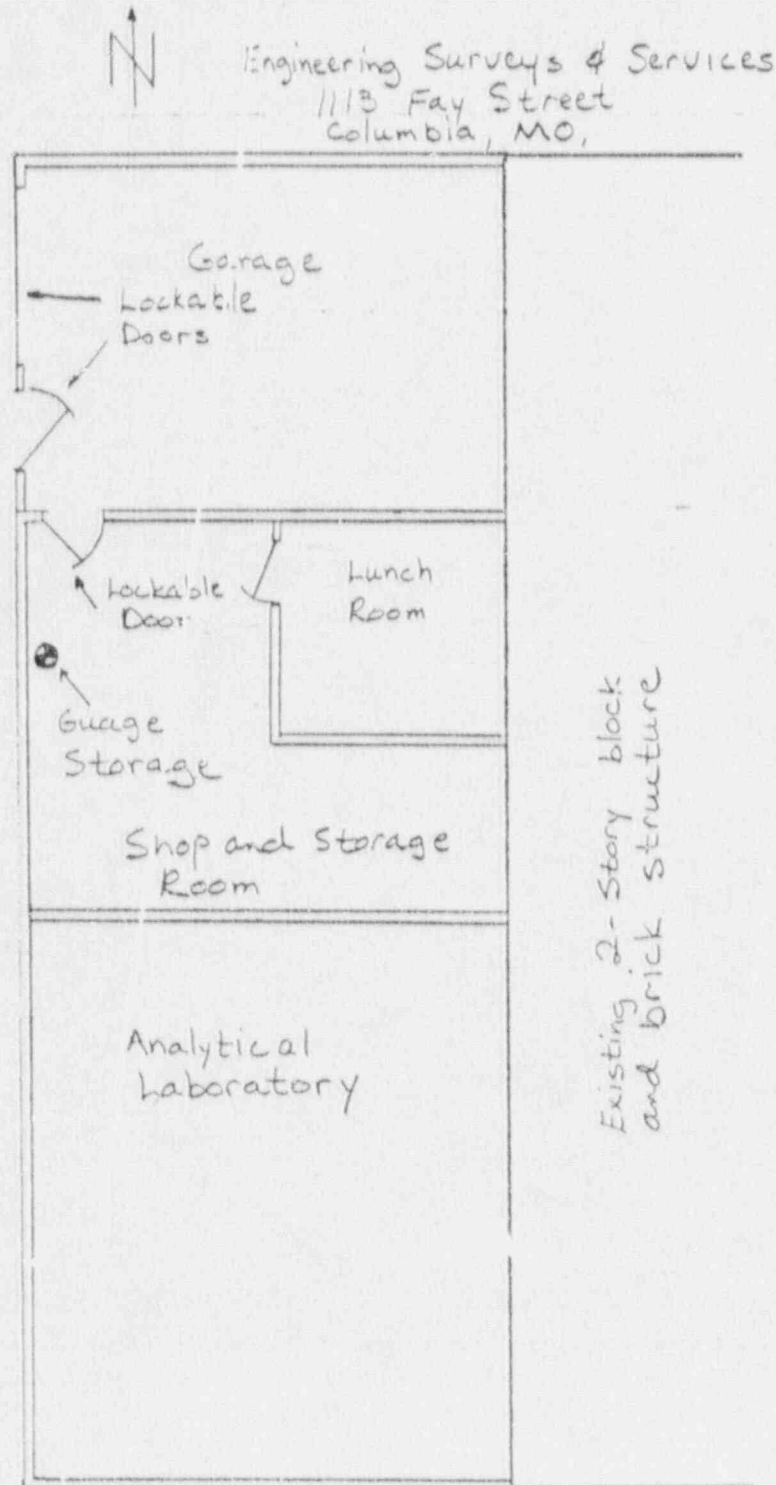

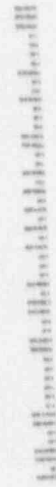


