Notification of Unusual Event Docket No. 50-382 Alert Site Area Emergency General Emergency Not Applicable SUBJECT: DECLARATION OF AN ALERT CLASSIFICATION DUE TO AN OCCIDENTAL CHEMICAL COMPANY CHLORINE GAS RELEASE At 8:43 p.m. on December 27, 1990, while the plant was operating at full pwer. the shift supervisor was notified via the industrial hotline that Occidental Chemical Company had experienced a power failure at the plant with a resultant chlorine release at a concentration of 0.02 ppm at the levee, which was near Occidental's size boundary. The Occidental plant is 0.8 miles southeast of Waterford 3. St. Charles Parish declared a site area emergency at 9:07 p.m., at which time the licensee entered their off-normal and emergency procedures which required sheltering of site personnel. At 9:16 p.m. the licensee declared an Alert classification as required by their emergency plan, and the appropriate notifications were made, including the NRC at 9:42 p.m. The control room air conditioning system was already in the isolation mode due to a normal air intake balancing problem identified earlier in the day. Slight increases above background were noted on the broad range and chlorine gas monitors, but the alarm points of 3 and 2 ppm, respectively, were not reached so an automatic isolation would not have occurred. Although the wind could have carried the plume to Waterford 3, nobody onsite reported any chlorine odor. St. Charles Parish exited their emergency classification with an "all clear" at 9:44 p.m., and at 10:04 p.m. the licensee terminated the event by exiting the Alert. As of this report, there were no reported injuries of the Waterford 3 or Occidental plant personnel. Media coverage has focused on the chlorine release and not on the Waterford facility. Although the licensee issued no press release, it brought some public information staff members into its corporate offices but received no inquiries. Region IV is prepared to respond to inquiries. The state of Louisiana has been informed. Region IV received notification of this occurrence by the HQ duty officer at 10:41 p.m. Region IV has informed the EDO's office, NRR project management, and
