
REQUEST FOR ACTION UNDER 10 CFR 2.206

Notice is hereby given that by its Petition to Suspend Construction of the South Texas Project dated August 4, 1982 (Petition), Citizens Concerned About Nuclear Power, Inc. (CCANP) requested that certain actions be taken by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission with respect to the South Texas Project of the Houston Lighting & Power Company, et al, in light of certain alleged design deficiencies. The relief requested included immediate suspension of construction at the South Texas Project, an independent third party review of the project design, and consideration by the Atomic Safety & Licensing Board to examine the alleged design deficiencies. The Petition is being treated pursuant to 10 CFR 2.206 of the Commission's regulations, and accordingly, action will be taken on the Petition within a reasonable time. Copies of the Petition are available for inspection in the Commission's Public Document Room, 1717 H Street, NW., Washington, D.C. 20555, and in the Local Public Document Room, for the South Texas Project, located at the Bay City Library, 1900 Fifth Street, Bay City, Texas 77414, and the Austin Public Library, 810 Guadalupe Street, Austin, Texas 78768.
