6 MR. CHILK: This is SECY-82-389, Metropolitan
7 Edison Company, TMI Unit I. The Commission in this
8 order is being asked to approve an order which would
9 address several issues related to the TMI restart
10 proceeding.

11 The order finds the Licensing Board did not
12 have the authority to impose a \$100,000 fine. It refers
13 the matter to the staff to determine whether a civil
14 penalty proceeding should be instituted. It would
15 direct the staff to investigate whether the licensee
16 made a material false statement.

17 The Chairman, Commissioners Ahearne, Roberts
18 and Asselstine have approved the order with several
19 modifications by Commissioners Ahearne and Roberts. One
20 modification proposed by Commissioner Roberts was
21 disapproved by the majority.

22 COMMISSIONER GILINSKY: Which one was that?

23 MR. CHILK: That was the one on page 6

24 COMMISSIONER GILINSKY: I see.

25 MR. CHILK: Commission Gilinsky have voted to

1 disapprove the order and has provided separate views.
2 Commissioner Roberts has additional views which have

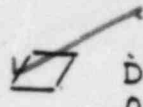
