NOTICE OF INTENT TO AMEND
THE UNIVERSITY OF CONNECTICUT
LAWS AND BY-LAWS

ARTICLE VIII.C AND D

C. Vice President for Finance [and Administration]

1. The Vice President for Finance [and Administration] is responsible to the President for the [coordination and] formulation of policies and [administration; coordination of the budget and [administrative,] business [and other support] departments of the University except for the University Health Center.

2. The Vice President for Finance [and Administration] shall:

a. through g. is unchanged.

h. Provide support to the President and to those reporting to the Office of the President by providing fiscal planning, coordination, and financial analysis services [Administration through Administrative Coordination and Planning.]

i. and j. is unchanged.

k. [Provide budget planning, coordination, and analysis support to those operations reporting to the Office of the President including Athletics, Development, Internal Auditing, Publications and Public Information, and Governmental Relations.]

l. Redesignated as k., is unchanged.

D. Vice President for Administration

1. The Vice President for Administration is responsible to the President for the formulation of policies and coordination of the administrative and other support departments of the University except for the Health Center.

2. The Vice President for Administration shall:

a. Attend all meetings of the Board of Trustees, except when the Board requests otherwise. He or she may participate in discussions but shall not vote.

- b. Be a member of the University Senate.
- c. Approve the selection and adjustment in service of all personnel under his or her jurisdiction.
- d. Assist directors and department heads in preparing budgets, and recommend budgets and budget adjustments in his or her area to the President.
- e. Administer the University's information systems, physical facilities, public safety functions and all other support units as the President may designate. He or she shall coordinate, organize, and develop existing or new support services to enhance the efficient operation of the University.
- f. Serve as an appellate agency for students or staff members in appeals from decisions of department heads supervised by him or her.
- g. Grant leaves of absence to members of the professional staff in those components organized under his or her supervision in conformity with the rules and regulations of the Board of Trustees; and, in granting leaves of absences without pay, designate whether such leaves were or were not granted for educational purposes in conformity with the State statutes and the policies of the Board of Trustees.
- h. Be a member of the President's cabinet.

The remainder of Article VIII is unchanged.
