In accordance with the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended the regulations thereunder, and provisions of 10CFR 50.54 (p), we hereby transmit five (5) copies of Revision 7, of the Salem Security Plan. This revision is deemed not to decrease the safeguards effectiveness of the plan and therefore does not represent a change to Operating Licenses DPR-70 and DPR-75 for Salem Generating Station Unit Nos. 1 and 2.

This revision reflects only a change in the corporate and station security organizations. The organization described in this revision is not fully staffed. Several new positions have been filled and candidates for the few remaining positions are being actively recruited. It is expected that all positions will be filled in the near future.
