BROWNS FERRY NUCLEAR PLANT (BFN) - GENERIC LETTER 89-13, SERVICE WATER SYSTEM PROBLEMS AFFECTING SAFETY-RELATED EQUIPMENT

By letter dated March 16, 1990, TVA responded to the subject Generic Letter. This letter included three commitments which were to be completed in the near term. These commitments were:

- (1) To include the current BFN heat exchanger inspection program in the preventative maintenance program by December 31, 1990 (This program would be revised to include the Shutdown Board Room Coolers and the H₂O₂ Analyzer Coolers),
- (2) To revise the Residual Heat Removal Service Water and Emergency Equipment Cooling Water systems maintenance instructions by December 31, 1990 to require notification of the system engineer if clams, excessive silt, or other blockage are present when the systems are opened, and
- (3) To revise training lesson plans for licensed and non-licensed operators, Maintenance and Technical training, and Chemistry training by January 31, 1991 to satisfy the Generic Letter.

The or ginal dates provided for these commitments were based on a Fall 1990 completion schedule for the work to restart BFN Unit 2. This work is still ongoing, therefore, these commitments will not be completed by the original dates provided. These commitments will be completed by March 31, 1991.
