In response to $\because$ ir letter of October 13, 1982, which transmitted Inspection Reporcs 50-282/82-16 and 50-306/82-16, the following iz offered:

## Violation

Technical Specification 6.5 requires implementation of procedures of the fire protection program. Administrative Control Directive 5 ACD 3.13, "Fire Prevention Practices," requires that "No Smoking" signs shall be posted in safetyrelated areas and that smoking shall not be permitted in such areas except for the Control Room.

Contrary to the above, at 11:30 A.M. (CDT) on September 14, 1982, the inspector observed:
a. "No Smoking" signs were not posted in the 12 Diesel Cooling Water Pump Room which is a safety-related area.
b. Two operators were smoking cigarettes in the 12 Diesel Cooling Water Pump Room while they were conducting a surveillance test.

This is a Severity Level V violation (Supplement I).

## Response

a. "No Smoking" signs have been posted in the Diesel Cooling Water Pump Rooms and all other safetyrelated areas have been reviewed to assure signs are posted. Full compliance has been achieved.
b. The individuals involved have been reinstructed regarding smoking in all safety-related areas. The Plant Manager has sent a letter to all plant personnel reminding them of the restrictions on smoking in all safety-related areas. Full compliance has been achieved.
