Dear Mr. Gigliotti:

This is in response to your letters of November 6 and December 6, 1990, which provided modifications to your physical security plan reflecting continuing decommissioning activities.

We have reviewed your proposed physical security plan changes and find some acceptable and some requiring further revisions. However, in the interest of time those changes requiring further revision are addressed in the enclosure to this letter. Acceptance of the proposed changes is based upon the changed nature of the SNM and subsequent physical protection strategy at your site. We find that with the implementation of the measures contained in the enclosure and the changes to your security plan (noted above) you continue to meet the provisions of Section 73.46.

Accordingly, we are hereby revising and reissuing Paragraph 9.1.A of the physical security portion of the Safeguards Amendment, designated as SG-2, to your License SNM-368 as reflected in the enclosure to this letter to be effective upon receipt of this letter.

9.0 Physical Protection Requirements For Strategic Special Nuclear Material
(See attachment for a listing of approved revisions)

9.1.A The licensee shall follow the physical protection plan entitled "UNC-Naval Products Physical Protection Plan," Revision 11, dated November 6, 1990 and Revision 11A, dated December 6, 1990, and as further revised in accordance with 10 CFR 70.32(e).

Notwithstanding statements to the contrary in the UNC Physical Protection Plan the licensee may:

- o Reduce the armed guard post at the "M" building entrance to single manning.
- o Use Tactical Response Team (TRT) personnel stationed at the EECF for onsite response.
- o Eliminate MAA vehicle escort on back shifts when the vehicles are not in use (provided the vehicles are secured).
- o Reduce the armed guard post at B-south to single manning and consider the SNM detectors at the "M" building exit as the second required search.
- o Relocate the tower guards to other posts (if alternate means of alarms assessment are provided).
- o Eliminate dual manning in B-south except for areas containing formula quantities of SNM.
- o Modify the MAA vehicle exit search to be compatible with the form of the material on hand.
