Required Surveillance Procedure

With the plant in Cold Shutdown, the LPCS System was declared inoperable when Surveillance Procedure 06-OP-1E21-M-0001 could not be completed on schedule. This resulted in only one of the two required ECCS Systems being operable. This event is being reported per T.S.3.5.2 and T.S.6.9.1.13.b. Attached is LER 82-092/03 L-0.
