Gentlemen:

Millstone Nuclear Power Station, Unit No. 1 Control Rod Accumulators

In Reference (1), Northeast Nuclear Energy Company (NNECO) proposed various Technical Specifications changes to support Reload 7/Cycle 8 at Millstone Unit No. 1. Item No. 10 in Attachment No. 3 to Reference (1) specifically requested the deletion of our Technical Specification requirement that an inoperable control rod accumulator must have no other non-fully disarmed control valve within the nine-rod square array around the affected rod. This change is no longer deemed desirable and thus we hereby withdraw our original request.
