## Gentlemen:

This refers to the special safety inspection conducted by W. J. Slawinski on June 18, 1982 and by D. J. Sreniawski, M. J. Oestmann, and S. Rozak on July 30, 1982, of activities at your facility located at 7943 New Jersey Avenue, Hammond, Indiana, to discussions with Mr. R. Adams at the Kennedy Industrial Park prior to and following the inspections and to discussions with you on August 9, 1982.

The inspection was conducted against your NRC License No. 13-11822-01, to ensure the radiological safety of the public and the security of the licensed material after this office was notified that you no longer controlled access to your facility or to the licensed material contained therein.

On July 30, 1982, the NRC took possession of five radiographic cameras containing four sources. This action was taken because of your apparent abandonment of the licensed material as indicated by your failure to respond to both my letter of June 22, 1982 and to the NRC Order to Show Cause issued July 22, 1982. The disposition of the sources was discussed with you on August 9, 1982, and is described in the enclosed inspection report.

No response to this letter is required at this time. You will receive separate enforcement correspondence from the Office of Inspection and Enforcement as a follow-up to the July 22, 1982 Order to Show Cause.
