Subject: Combined Inspection 50-277/82-04 and 50-278/82-04

This refers to your letter dated May 20, 1982, in response to our letter dated April 21, 1982. You requested in Appendix A to your letter that the item identified in the Notice of Violation enclosed with our April 21, 1982 letter be reconsidered and withdrawn as a violation. Based upon a review of the circumstances, we have concluded that the item was correctly classified as a violation because the last person to control access could not promptly respond to an attempted intrusion by locking the turnstiles to the protected area.

Thank you for informing us of the corrective and preventive action taken as documented in your letter. We appreciate your prompt and sound resolution of the matter. The action taken was examined during a recent emergency preparedness drill at your facility by Mr. Jack Dunlap of this office and found to be satisfactory.

In accordance with 10 CFR 73.21 of the NRC's regulations, documentation of security measures for the physical protection of special nuclear materials and certain plant equipment vital to the safety of production or utilization facilities is deemed to be Safeguards Information. Each person who produces, receives or acquires Safeguards Information is required to ensure that it is protected against unauthorized disclosure. Therefore, the enclosure to your letter will not be placed in the Public Document Room and will receive limited distribution pursuant to 10 CFR 73.21(c).
