a. Item 6A, add the phrase, "with half lives less than 120 days "after" ... Atomic Numbers 3 to 83 inclusive..."

b. Item 8A, add the phrase, "with half lives less than 120 days "after" "...Atomic Numbers 3 to 83 inclusive..."

c. Item 6B, delete Technetium 99m

d. Item 8B, change 20 Curies to 1.0 Curie

e. Insert new items 6C, 7C, and 8C

6C: "Technetium-99m"; 7C: "Any"; 8C: "2.0 Curies"

f. Delete old items 6C, 7C, and 8C referring to Phosphorus 32

g. Delete old items 6D, 7D, and 8D referring to Gold 198.

h. Old item 8E, Iodine-131, now item 8D, change: "1.5 Curies" to: "500 millicuries."

i. Old item 8F, Iodine-125, now item 8E, change: "1.0 Curie" to: "100 millicuries."

j. Old item 8G, Xenon-133, now item 8F, change: "3.0 Curies" to: "500 millicuries."

k. Old item 8H, Hydrogen-3, now item 8G, change: "2.0 Curies" to: "500 millicuries."

l. Insert new items 6H, 7H, and 8H:

6H: "Calcium-45"; 7H: "Any"; 8H: "20 millicuries"

m. Insert new items 6I, 7I, and 8I:

q. Insert new items 6M, 7M, and 8M:




r. Current items I through N remain the same, but the item designations will be changed to O through T, respectively.
