



- i. Old it as 8F, Iodine-125, now item 8E, change: "1.0 Curie" to: "100 millicuries."
- j. Old item 8G, Xenon-133, now item 8F, change: "3.0 Curies" to: "500 millicuries."
- k. Old item 8H, Hydrogen-3, now item 8G, change: "2.0 Curies" to: "500 millicuries."
