Violation of National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit

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Attached are two revised copies of the September 1990 NPDES report for the Trojan Nuclear Plant. These should replace the copies proviously submitted (letter from R. J. Hess dated October 10, 1990).

The revisions are as follows:

- Cover letter Page 2. The first sentence of the next to last paragraph begins, "The main plant outfall pH monitor was out-of-service from 1703 hours on September 10 to 1705 hours on September 14...".
- Discharge Monitoring Report (DMR) forms. Numbering was completed in the lower right hand corner of each page (i.e. 1 of 1, 1 of 2 etc).
