Dear Mr. Thomas:

In response to your Notice of Violation as a result of the NRC special safety inspection conducted by Mr. D. Skov on October 1, 1982 at the Hunters Point Naval Shipyard, we wish to advise that the following steps have been taken to correct this incident and to avoid further non-compliance infractions on our part:

- Item 1. David D. Skov was notified by phone that Western Industrial X-Ray would be providing radiographic inspection aboard the USS FLINT and the USS WABASH for the period October 1-3, 1982. NRC Form 241 was submitted. We then discovered this would be an on-going job. Again we contacted Mr. Skov, following up with NRC Form 241 to cover period October 4 - December 31, 1982.
- Item 2. Our customers have been requested to give our office advance notice when scheduling radiographic inspection service. This would allow us ample time to notify your department of proposed activity.
- Item 3. Compliance has been met.

I assure you that our Company is very safety-conscious and we will make every effort to comply with the regulations set forth under general license provisions of 10 CFR 150.20, and in accordance with the NRC Enforcement Policy (10 CFR Part 2, Appendix C) 47 FR 9987 (March 9, 1982) to insure safe working conditions for our employees and those we provide service for.
